PORT OF LIVERPOOL

QUEEN MARY 2 - INAUGURAL ARRIVAL: 20TH OCTOBER 2009

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday 20th October 2009, the liner Queen Mary 2 will be making her first call to the Port of Liverpool.

The vessel is expected to be transiting the Approach Channel at 0930 hours, entering the river at 1030 hours and off the Liverpool Cruise Facility at the Pier Head at 1100 hours. Prior to berthing the vessel will swing in the river to head outward before proceeding alongside. The vessel will be departing Liverpool at 2300 hours the same day.

All vessels, including recreational and leisure craft are reminded that she will be constrained by her draft and that they must keep well clear of her at all times.

Mariners navigating within the port area should aim to pass at least 50 metres clear of the vessel at all times even when she is berthed alongside, the Queen Mary 2 will be escorted by the Merseyside Police Launch "Consortium".
