WORK ON THE ALEXANDRA – LANGTON DOCK PASSAGE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT ON OR AROUND MONDAY 24TH SEPTEMBER 2007 CONSTRUCTION WORK WILL COMMENCE IN THE PASSAGEWAY CONNECTING ALEXANDRA DOCK AND LANGTON DOCK.

THE WORK WILL INVOLVE THE FABRICATION OF STEEL SHUTTERING CLOSE TO THE EXISTING PILE FACE TO CREATE A CONCRETE WALL ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE PASSAGEWAY.

DURING THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE CONCRETE FACE UNIFLOATS WILL BE POSITIONED AT THE NORTHWEST AND SOUTHWEST CORNERS OF THE PASSAGEWAY REDUCING THE WIDTH OF THE PASSAGE TO A MAXIMUM OF 36 METRES. THE UNIFLOATS WILL BE ILLUMINATED AT NIGHT.

FOR THE DURATION OF THE INTENDED WORKS THE MAXIMUM BEAM FOR ANY VESSEL WISHING TO TRANSIT THE PASSAGE WILL BE NO GREATER THAN 32 METRES.

IT IS ANTICIPATED THAT THE WORK WILL CONTINUE FOR A PERIOD OF APPROXIMATELY SEVEN WEEKS.

MASTERS OF VESSELS ARE REMINDED THAT THEY MUST SEEK PERMISSION FROM THE LANGTON DOCK MASTERS OFFICE ON V.H.F. CHANNEL 21 BEFORE ATTEMPTING TO TRANSIT THE PASSAGEWAY.
