LIVERPOOL CRUISE LINER FACILITY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT ON OR ABOUT WEDNESDAY 10TH OCTOBER 2007 FURTHER WORK WILL COMMENCE ON THE TWO FLOATING PONTOONS AT THE NORTH END OF LIVERPOOL LANDING STAGE.

THESE TWO MOST NORTHERN PONTOONS WILL BE REMOVED TO A DRY DOCK FOR A TEMPORARY PERIOD.

THIS WILL EFFECTIVELY REDUCE THE LENGTH OF THE CRUISE LINER BERTHING FACILITY TO 135 METRES.

THE PONTOONS WILL BE TOWED ONE AT A TIME TO DRY DOCK.

ON COMPLETION OF EACH MOVE OF THE PONTOONS THE MOST NORTHERN END OF THE CRUISE LINER FACILITY WILL BE MARKED BY THREE FIXED RED LIGHTS IN THE FORM OF A TRIANGLE.

MARINERS ARE ADVISED TO KEEP WELL CLEAR AND REDUCE SPEED WHEN PASSING DURING OPERATIONS TO REMOVE THE PONTOONS.
