

GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR NAVIGATION IN THE PORT OF LIVERPOOL (No.7)

The Mersey Docks and Harbour Company, in exercise of their powers under the Mersey Docks and Harbour Board Act 1971, give the following general directions to vessels in the Port of Liverpool ("the Port").

TALL SHIPS RACES – PARADE OF SAIL 21ST JULY 2008

1. The following sections of the River Mersey shall be closed to all vessels not involved in the organisation of the Parade of Sail or taking part in the Parade itself at the following times on the 21st July 2008.

- 1) Closed from 1200 hours to 1700 hours inclusive, an area bounded by a line drawn from Canada Buoy through Tower Buoy and a line drawn from G7 Buoy through E3 Buoy.
- 2) Closed from 1400 hours to 1700 hours inclusive an area bounded by a line drawn from Canada Buoy through Tower Buoy and a line drawn from C22 Buoy through Brazil Buoy.

During these periods all vessels not involved in the organisation of the Parade or the Parade itself shall remain on their river berths or in dock, anchor in the spectator vessels anchorage (see attached plan) or moor or anchor in the pleasure craft spectator area (see attached plan) as appropriate. Any vessel intending to enter the Port from the sea during the above times shall remain at anchor in the vicinity of the Bar until 1700 hour on that day.
