LIVERPOOL BAY

**GEOPHYSICAL SURVEY - 12<sup>TH</sup> to 26<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2009**

ALL VESSELS NAVIGATING IN THE APPROACHES TO LIVERPOOL ARE ADVISED THAT SURVEY VESSEL RV DISCOVERY WILL BE CONDUCTING SEABED SURVEYS IN THE AREA SHOWN BELOW. SHE WILL BE OPERATING 24 HOURS A DAY AND TOWING EQUIPMENT UP TO 150M ASTERN AT A SPEED OF 3 TO 6 KNOTS. THE VESSEL IS 24 M LOA WITH CALL-SIGN 2AEL8. SHE WILL MONITOR VHF CH 16 AND DISPLAY "RESTRICTED ABILITY TO MANOEUVRE" DAY SHAPES AND LIGHTS AS REQUIRED BY COLREGS RULE 27.

AREA TO BE SURVEYED IS BOUNDED BY THE POSITIONS BELOW. SEE ATTACHED CHART.
