Membership Application

Dear Prospective member,

Thank you for your enquiry. Application of the Club is at present open and the following information is aimed at assisting you. We are a members club, affiliated to the Royal Yachting Association. Our main objectives are to promote the activities of yachting and boating, and provide social and other facilities for members... To these ends the members have elected a management committee who administer the Constitution and Rules and who liaise with the marina whose premises we use, and with other bodies on matters affecting the interests of the members.

The Constitution and Rules and members of the management committee are listed in the yearbook, a copy of which will be given to you on election as a member. Election to, and renewal of membership implies acceptance of the Constitution & Rules.

Election of members.

Rule 6:1 Candidates for election.

Application for membership (except Honorary Membership) shall be proposed and seconded by voting members of the Club, Both of which shall be acquainted with the candidate.

Rule 6:2 Applications

Application for membership shall be in the form approved by the management committee and shall include the category of membership requested, the name, address, and occupation of the candidate, together with the name of proposer and seconder
A cheque made payable to LYC for the subscription and entrance fee with application form.

Rule 6:3 Elections of Members.

A completed application for membership shall be submitted to the Membership Secretary who shall post the application on the club notice board for at least 14 days prior to the date of the management meeting at which the application is to be considered. The election of Members is vested in the management committee and each elected candidate shall be informed in writing of the decision of the Management Committee and given a copy of these rules.

Rule 6:4 Payments of Fees

On election the candidate's cheque, submitted in accordance with rule 6:2 above, will be paid into LYC bank account. In the event that the candidate is not elected, the cheque will be returned with advice of non-election.

Rule 6:5 Subscriptions

Subscriptions are payable on the first day of January each year. A member elected after the first day of July each year shall pay half the annual subscription for that year. A member elected after the first day of November and before the last day of December shall not be required to pay for the annual subscription that year, but shall pay subscription for the next year with their application for membership.

Bye Law No. 1: The Committee has the power to vary the fees in particular cases.

Yearbooks are issued on payment of membership fees or on membership acceptance.

A Bewa (swipe) card is needed to access the Marina and these should be purchased from the Marina Office
