Membership Application

Dear Prospective member.

Thank you for your enquiry. Application for membership of both Liverpool Yacht Club and Tranmere Sailing Club is open to all members of the public and the following information is aimed at assisting you. We are a member's clubs, affiliated to the Royal Yachting Association. Our main objectives are to promote the activities of yachting and boating, and provide social and other facilities for members. Members have elected a management committee who administer the Constitution and Rules and liaise with other bodies on matters affecting the interests of the members.

The Constitution and Rules and members of the management committee are listed in the yearbook, a copy of which will be given to you on election as a member. Election to, and renewal of membership implies acceptance of the Constitution & Rules.

4 Membership of the club shall be open to anyone interested in the sport of yachting on application regardless of sex, age, disability, ethnicity, nationality, sexual orientation, religion or other beliefs. Membership may however be limited according to available facilities on a non-discriminatory basis.

6.1 Application. An application for membership shall be in the form approved by the Committee, and shall include the category of membership requested, the name, address and occupation of the candidate. A cheque for the Entrance Fee and Subscription must be submitted with the application. **(Cheques to be payable to Liverpool Yacht Club.)**

6.2 Election of Members A completed application for membership shall be submitted to the Membership Secretary. The election of all classes of Members is vested in the Committee and shall be a simple majority vote of those of the Committee. (a) The Committee may refuse applications only for good cause such as conduct or character likely to bring the club into disrepute. The Membership Secretary shall inform each candidate in writing of the candidate's election or non election and each elected candidate shall be given a copy of these Rules. (b) Appeal against refusal to elect may be made to members in General Meeting.

6.3 Payments of Fees. On election the candidate's cheque, submitted in accordance with rule 6:1 above, will be paid into LYC in the event that the candidate is not elected, the cheque will be returned with advice of non-election.

6.4 Subscriptions. Subscriptions are payable on the first day of January each year. A member elected after the first day of July each year shall pay half the annual subscription for that year. A member elected after the first day of November and before the last day of December shall not be required to pay for the annual subscription that year, but shall pay subscription for the next year with their application for membership.
